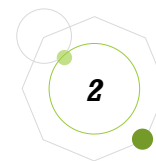



Ljubljana - Slovenia's capital and largest city is one of Europe's greenest and most liveable capitals; it was the European Commission's Green Capital of Europe in 2016.

Lake Bled - bluish-green lake, picture-postcard church on an islet, a medieval castle clinging to a rocky cliff and some of the highest peaks of the Julian Alps make it most popular resort in Slovenia.

Enjoy your day on Lake Bled and visit another highlight of Slovenia – Vintgar Gorge. The highlight of Vintgar is a 1600m wooden walkway through the gorge, built in 1893 and continually rebuilt since. It criss-crosses the swirling Radovna River four times over rapids, waterfalls and pools before reaching 16m-high Šum Waterfall.

Day 5: Predjama & Postojna Cave

Underground wonderland



Underground wonderland

Predjama Castle - one of Europe's most dramatic castles. It teaches a clear lesson: if you want to build an impregnable fortification, put it in the gaping mouth of a cavern halfway up a 123m cliff. Its four storeys were built piecemeal over the years from 1202, but most of what you see today is from the 16th century. It looks simply unconquerable.

The karst cave at Postojna is one of the largest in the world, and its stalagmite and stalactite formations are unequalled anywhere.

Rovinj & Motovun



Discover Istria

Rovinj is coastal Istria's star attraction. The old town is contained within an egg-shaped peninsula, webbed with steep cobbled streets and small squares, and punctuated by a tall church tower rising from the highest point. Originally an island, it was only connected to the mainland in 1763 when the narrow channel separating it was filled.

Motovun is a captivating little walled town perched on a 277m hill in the Mirna River valley. The setting is astonishingly gorgeous and a large part of its appeal is in the lost-in-time views over the verdant valley, with the town rising above it like something from a fairy tale. The damp, dark Motovun Forest at its base also has a mythical quality, especially as it contains hidden treasure in the form of Istria's famous truffles.

Experience both places in a day, try truffle specialties, admire magnificent old architecture and amazing nature of Istrian inland.

Roman heritage in Pula

A wealth of Roman architecture lifts otherwise-workaday Pula from the humdrum. The star of the show is the remarkably well-preserved Roman amphitheatre, smack in the heart of the city, which dominates the streetscape and doubles as a venue for summer concerts and festivals.

Enjoy walking around Pula while discovering its gems, have a lunch and continue Your journey towards Velebit & Plitvice Lakes, where You'll spend a night and prepare for a morning tour of the National Park

National Park Plitvice Lakes & Zadar



Rastoke & Plitvice Lakes

By far Croatia's top natural attraction and the absolute highlight of Croatia.

Within the boundaries of this heavily forested national park, 16 crystalline lakes tumble into each other via a series of waterfalls and cascades. The mineral-rich waters carve through the rock, depositing tufa in continually changing formations. Clouds of butterflies drift above the 18km of wooden footbridges and pathways that snake around the edges and across the rumbling water.

Experience Šibenik & Trogir

Šibenik has a magnificent medieval heart, gleaming white against the placid waters of the bay, something that may not be immediately apparent as you drive through the somewhat shabby outskirts. The stone labyrinth of steep backstreets and alleys is a joy to explore...

Private 90min walking tour of Šibenik.
Private transfer from Šibenik to Split with stopover in Trogir for sightseeing.

Trogir is set within medieval walls on a tiny island, linked by bridges to both the mainland and to the far larger Čiovo Island. The old town has retained many intact and beautiful buildings from its age of glory between the 13th and 15th centuries. In 1997 its profuse collection of Romanesque and Renaissance buildings earned it World Heritage status.

Welcome to Montenegro

Bursting at the seams with majestic mountains, breathtaking beaches and larger-than-life locals, minuscule Montenegro proves once and for all that good things do indeed come in small packages.

Relax and enjoy in the wonderful drive through Hercegovina region towards Montenegro.

Before reaching final destination for the day, we will make a stop in Ostrog.

Resting improbably – miraculously? – in a cliff face 900m above the Zeta valley, the gleaming white Ostrog Monastery is the most important site in Montenegro for Orthodox Christians, attracting up to a million visitors annually. Even with its numerous pilgrims, tourists and souvenir stands, it's a strangely affecting place.

Arrival to a final destination for the day, Žabljak in late afternoon hours.

Day 14: Durmitor National Park

Feel Durmitor... Black Lake,

Feel Durmitor

The impossibly rugged and dramatic Durmitor (Дурмитор) is one of Montenegro's – and Mother Nature's – showpieces. Carved out by glaciers and underground streams, Durmitor stuns with dizzying canyons, glittering glacial lakes and nearly 50 limestone peaks soaring to over 2000m.

The elegant spans of the 150m-high Tara Bridge were completed just as WWII was starting. At the time it was the largest concrete arched vehicular bridge in Europe. Its 365m length is carried on five sweeping arches, the largest of which is 116m wide.

Visit Đurđevica-Tara bridge, experience a zip-line or just admire the view on one of the most amazing canyons in Europe. Later enjoy walk around the Black Lake and relax spending Your day in this wonderful National Park.

Bay of Kotor

Gorgeous, breathtaking, majestic, divine; however hefty your thesaurus, the brain-blowing beauty of the Bay of Kotor will leave you struggling for superlatives. Hemmed in by commanding cliffs and shape-shifting between rippling gulfs and sparkling straits, the cobalt cove even manages to defy geographic description: is it a fjord? A submerged canyon? It seems there's only one way to define Boka Kotorska: unmissable.

Enjoy relaxed drive from Žabljak to Kotor, experience it's core with local guide. After tour enjoy free time for lunch at Your own expense. After Kotor drive continues towards Dubrovnik with a stop in another gem of Montenegro; Perast.

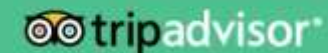
