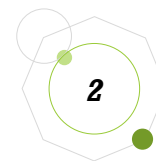

Day 3 : Zagreb - Plitvice Lakes - Šibenik

National Park Plitvice Lakes & Rastoke



Rastoke & Plitvice Lakes

By far Croatia's top natural attraction and the absolute highlight of Croatia.

Within the boundaries of this heavily forested national park, 16 crystalline lakes tumble into each other via a series of waterfalls and cascades. The mineral-rich waters carve through the rock, depositing tufa in continually changing formations. Clouds of butterflies drift above the 18km of wooden footbridges and pathways that snake around the edges and across the rumbling water.

Zagreb – Rastoke 100min drive
Rastoke – Plitvice Lakes 35min drive
Plitvice – Šibenik 120min drive

Experience Split & Trogir

Split is a great place to see Dalmatian life as it's really lived. Always buzzing, this exuberant city has just the right balance between tradition and modernity. It's heart – the Diocletian's Palace is a Unesco World Heritage Site and one of the world's most impressive Roman monuments.

Trogir is set within medieval walls on a tiny island, linked by bridges to both the mainland and to the far larger Čiovo Island. The old town has retained many intact and beautiful buildings from its age of glory between the 13th and 15th centuries. In 1997 its profuse collection of Romanesque and Renaissance buildings earned it World Heritage status.

Day 6: Food & Wine experience on Pelješac

Oysters, wine and more...



Experience Food, wine & more

Start from Split - 9.00am.

Split – Ston 2h30m drive.

Flanking the isthmus that connects the Pelješac Peninsula with the mainland, Ston and Mali Ston – are famous for three things: salt, oysters and the remarkable 5.5km defensive wall that links them.

After Ston You'll head to nearby village to board the boat .

Captian will take You with a boat through the mussels & oysters bay and You will taste some of the best oysters & mussels in the world

After mussels & oysters experience journey towards Korčula island will start. Stop in the family owned winery on the peninsula. Journey in the vehicle through the peninsula is about one hour long after which comes a 15min long ferry ride(15:40/16:30) to the Korčula island.

Arrival to Korčula around 4.15pm

Korčula Town is a stunner. Ringed by imposing defences, this coastal citadel is dripping with history, with marble streets rich in Renaissance and Gothic architecture.

Enjoy morning in one of the most beautiful Croatian islands and meet Your driver/guide around 12.00 to head towards Dubrovnik. After short ferry ride(12:40) enjoy the wonderful drive through the amazing landscape of Pelješac peninsula.

Before reaching Dubrovnik You'll make a stop in Trsteno (110min drive from Orebić) to visit one of the oldest arboretums in this part of the world.

Arrival to Dubrovnik in the late afternoon hours.

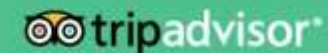
